Hall County Tax Commissioner's Office Closure

GAINESVILLE, Ga (September 26). In response to the approaching Hurricane Helene, the Hall County Tax Commissioner's Office has made the decision to close the office Friday, September 27th. The office will reopen Monday, September 30th at 8 am. The safety and well-being of our team and community members remain our top priority. Additionally, the GA Dept of Revenue, which provides our software for motor vehicle operations and staff support is closed today and Friday. The state's penalty for renewing decals late is removed for today and tomorrow as part of the authority in offering our non-essential services.

We urge everyone to follow best practices recommended by the National Weather Service, which include stocking up on three days worth of food per person in your household, filling up your gas tank, and keeping your cell phones charged in anticipation of potential power outages.

We appreciate your understanding during this time and encourage everyone to stay safe. We will provide updates as the situation evolves.
