Georgia drivers can now renew their licenses at grocery stores, including 2 in Hall County

Georgia drivers can now add renewing their license to their grocery list.

New kiosks at select Kroger and Publix stores throughout the state will allow residents to renew their driver's license and vehicle registration.

The service is a partnership with the Georgia Department of Revenue and the Department of Driver Services. DDS has now joined 53 existing DOR self-service Kiosks at Kroger locations and five at Publix locations.

At the kiosks, customers can enter their personal information, have their photograph taken and make payment for their licenses. They will need to authenticate the transaction by either scanning their license or manually entering their driver's license number. Once validated, the customer will see a display of eligible services at that kiosk.

Customers using the DDS Kiosk will save \$5 on the transaction fee.

"This is a perfect example of two state agencies coming together for the betterment of the community," DDS Commissioner Spencer R. Moore stated in a news release. "Using a self-service kiosk is a secure and efficient method to handle two of Georgia's important processes even when state offices are closed."

Currently, the two stores in Hall County with a DDS Kiosk are the Clearwater Crossing Kroger at 7380 Spout Springs Rd., and the New Holland Kroger at 1931 Jesse Jewel Parkway, SE.
