2025 Property Tax Bills Delayed Due to State-Wide Legislation

Gainesville, GA (September 18, 2025) – Hall County Tax Commissioner Darla Eden CPA is informing residents that 2025 property tax bills for real estate and personal property will be delayed due to recent state-wide legislative changes.

Typically, property tax bills are mailed on September 15 with a November 15 due date. However, adjustments required by Georgia House Bill 581 have impacted the timeline for counties across Georgia, including Hall County. Despite the delay, the due date for payment will remain 60 days from the date bills are mailed, which gives the taxpayers time to plan and make payment.

“Our office is working diligently to ensure that property tax bill content and format comply with the new legislative requirements,” said Eden. “Although the mailing date hasn’t been finalized, we anticipate it will be in mid-November. We appreciate the public’s patience and understanding during this transition.”
