Purpose of This Page

Comment Guidelines

We welcome comments that are respectful and relevant. Comments are moderated in a viewpoint-neutral manner. To maintain a productive environment, the following types of content may be hidden or removed:

- **Vulgarity:** Obscene, profane, or abusive language, including "masked" vulgarity using symbols or creative misspellings to bypass filters.

- **Threats & Harassment:** Specific threats of violence, personal attacks, or defamatory statements directed at staff or other users.

- **Sensitive Information:** The posting of private identifying information for your own protection and the protection of others.

- **Discrimination:** Content that promotes or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, national origin, physical or mental disability, or sexual orientation.

- **Solicitation & Spam:** Commercial advertising, repetitive posts ("spam"), or links to third-party websites.

- **Off-Topic Content:** Content clearly unrelated to the specific topic of the post or the operations of the Tax Commissioner's Office.

- **Platform Standards:** Any content that violates Meta Platforms (Facebook/Instagram) or X Community Standards.
